

Lattice split card

Base – Thick White cardstock
10.5 x 29.7cm (half A4 lengthwise)

Fold in half and burnish scoreline

Cut a 10cm piece off the end on one side

Slice this 10cm piece into 5 pieces 1.5 x 10.5cm and 2 pieces 1 x 10.5cm

Using grid paper, lay the 1.5 cm pieces out horizontally, edges lined up on the grid paper, with a 0.5cm gap between the pieces.

Adhere the 1cm wide strip vertically, 1.5cm from the left edge of the horizontal strips, with the bottom lined up with the bottom of the last strip – it will overhang at the top.

Repeat with the second strip, this time 1.5cm in from the right hand edge

Now attach this to the flap of the card base, lining the bottom of the strips up with the bottom of the card base.

Stamp the smaller daisy image three times using Lemon Lolly ink. Stamp the centre using Daffodil Delight ink.

Using a blender, pick up some Daffodil Delight ink from the lid of the ink pad and 'flick' the colour out from the edge of the centre of the flower. Repeat for all three flowers.

Die cut the three flowers out.

Die cut the leafy piece from Granny Apple Green cardstock twice.

Adhere the leafy pieces, one above and one to the right (see photo for placement)

Adhere two of the daisies flat on the card, and the third one up on Dimensionals

Stamp the sentiment in Granny Apple Green ink onto a piece of Basic White cardstock and die cut using the label die in the bundle.

Use the same die to cut out a piece of Granny Apple Green cardstock. Cut this in half lengthwise and adhere to the sentiment piece so they overhang at the top and bottom.

Adhere to the top right of the card using dimensionals

Adhere a 10.5 x 14.85cm piece of Soft Sea Foam cardstock to the inside of the card base.
